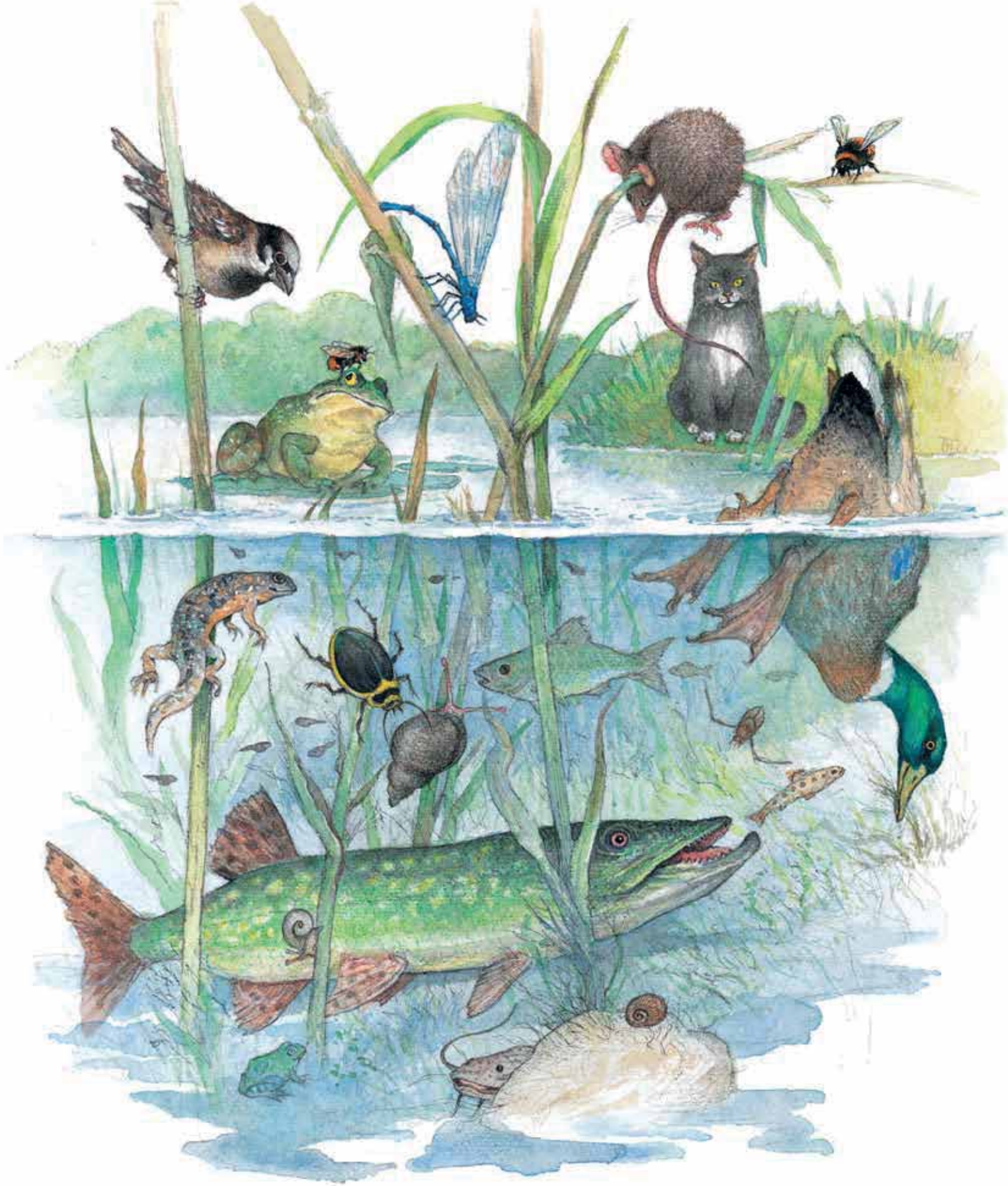


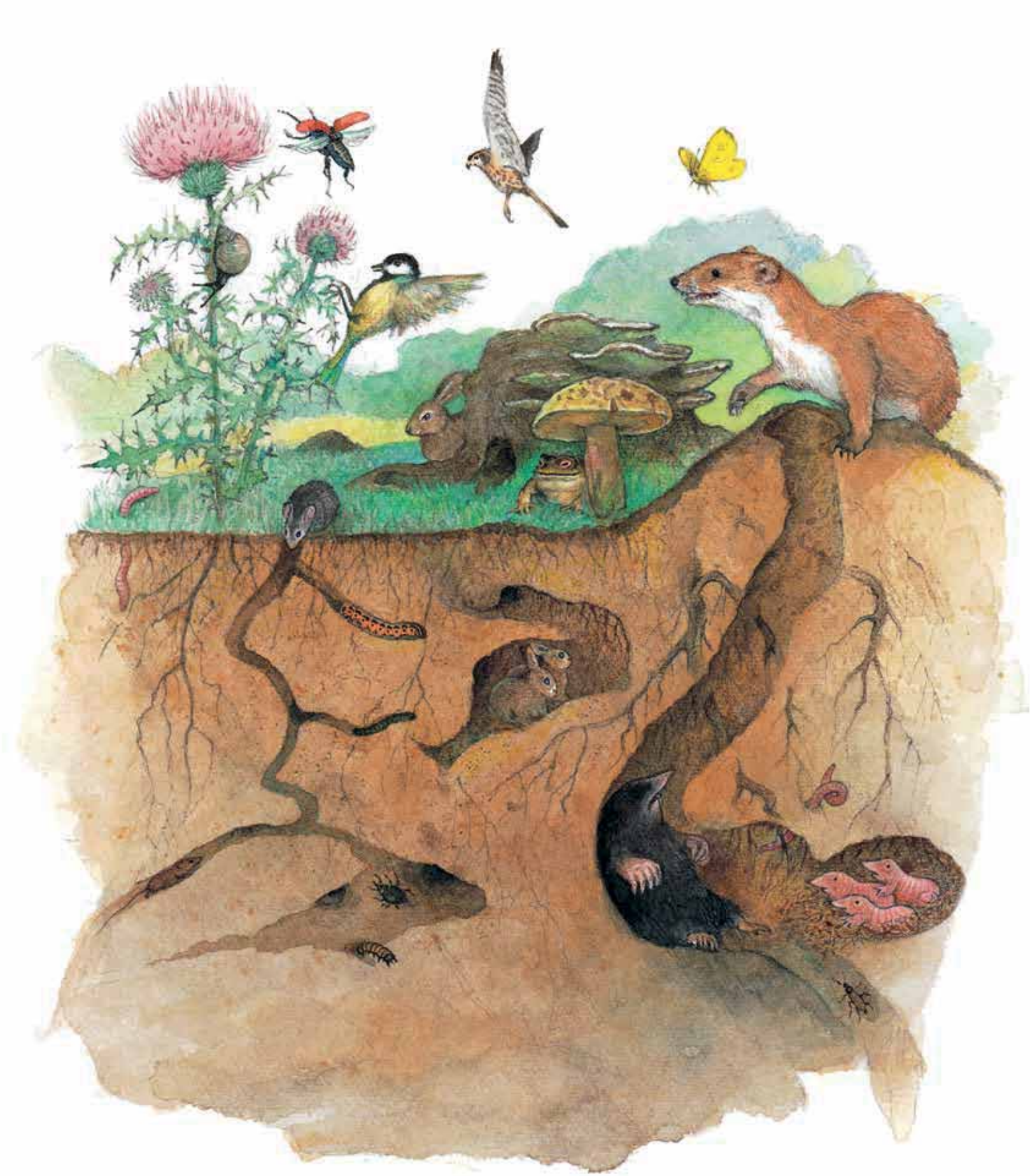
What will pop out of these eggs?
Pointed beaks and scaly legs!



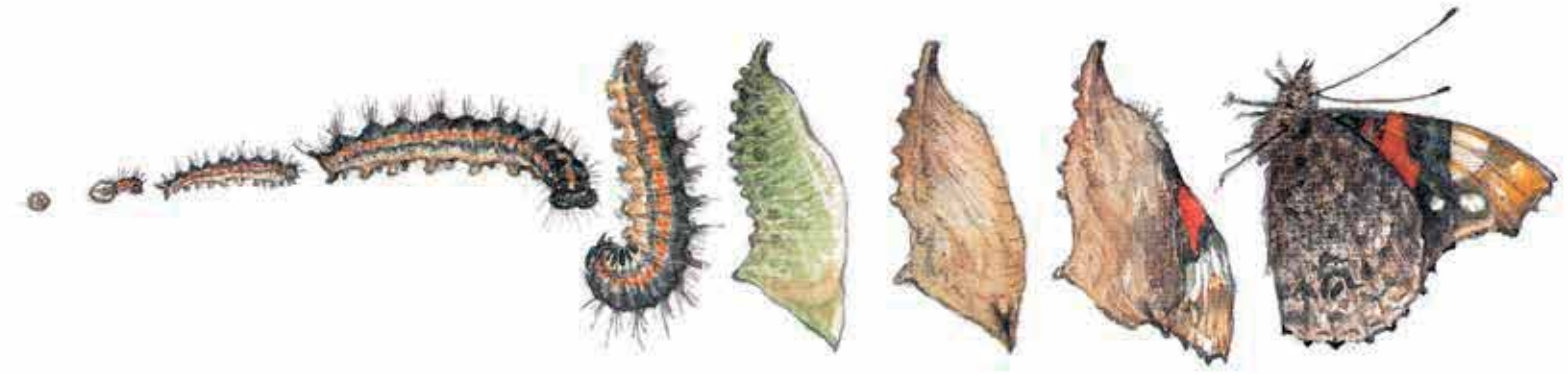
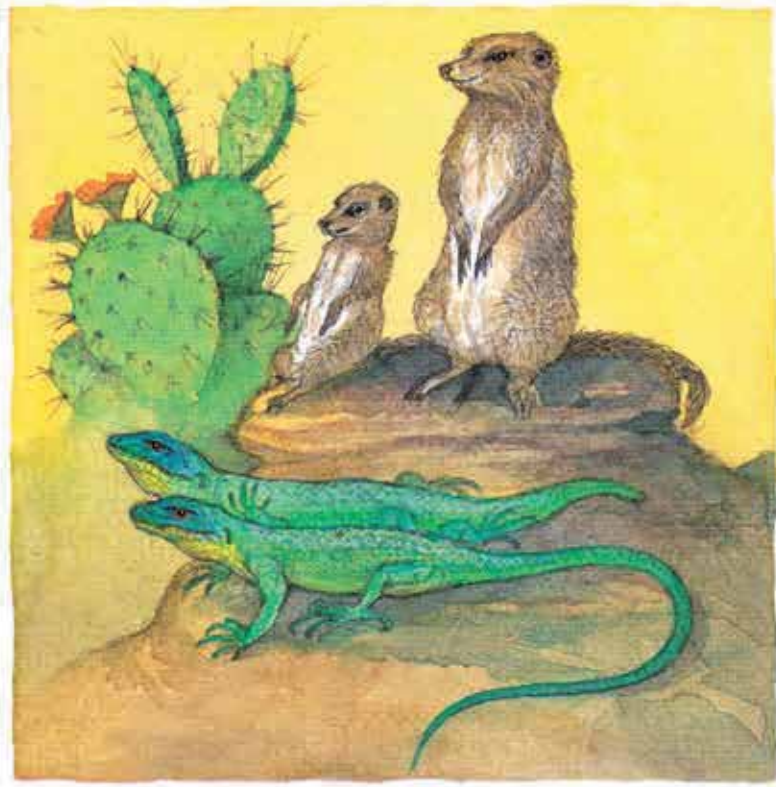
Feathers of many colors,

And some perch over water or sit carefully where it's dry.



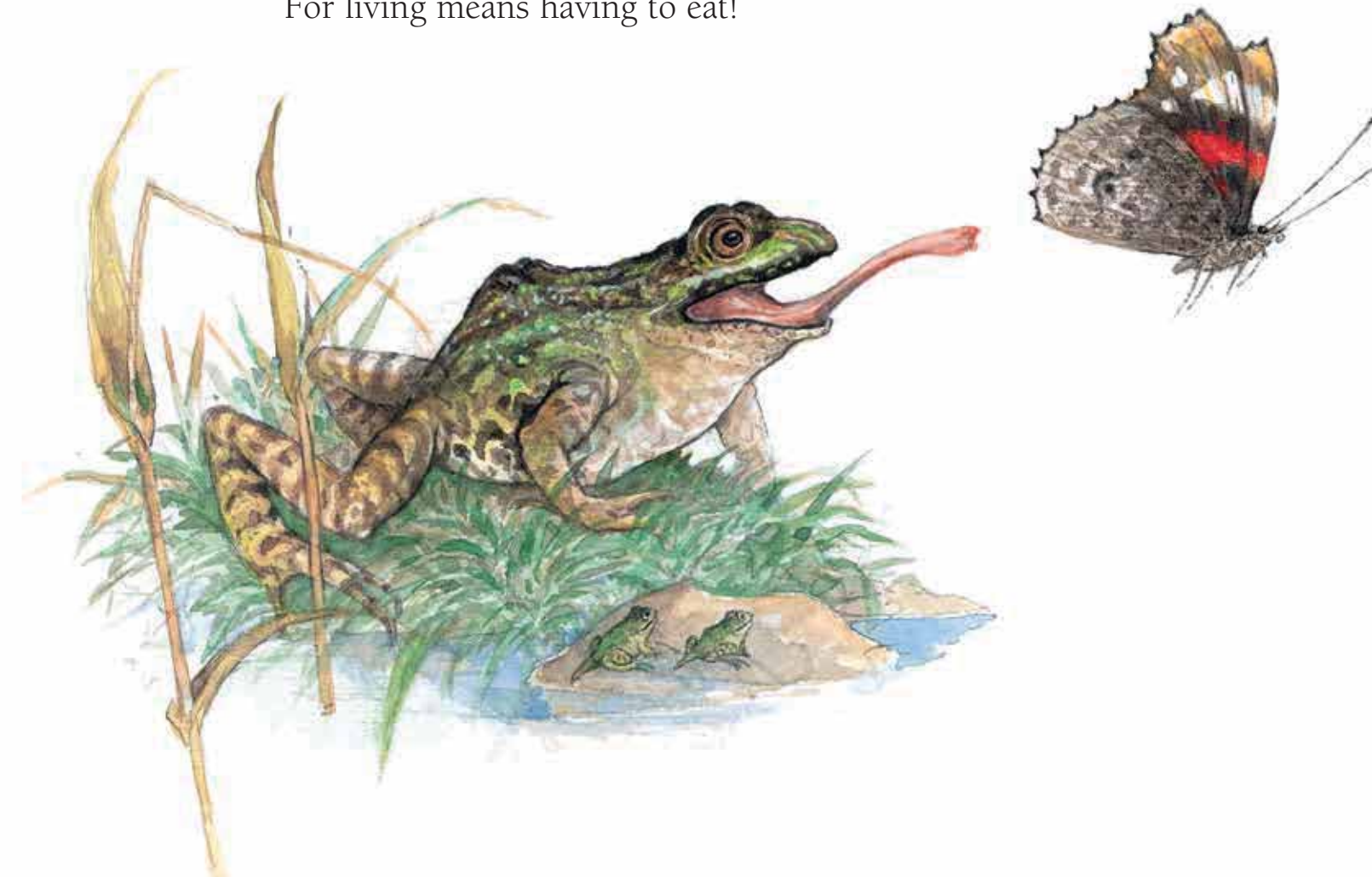
Who glides? Who flies? Who flutters in the air?
And who would rather disappear deep down inside a lair?

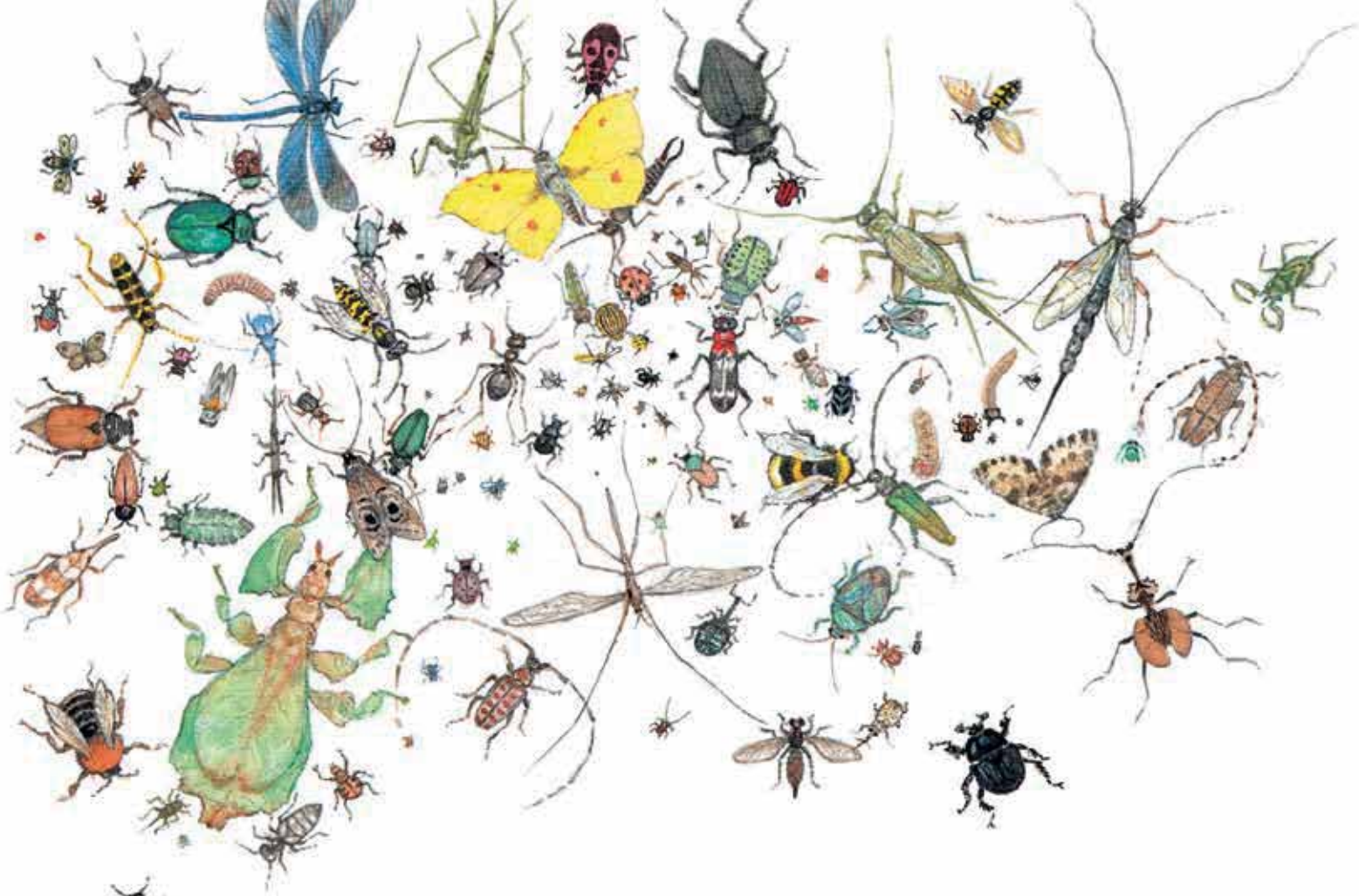


Some even grow up and don't look the same.
What a trick! What a magical feat!

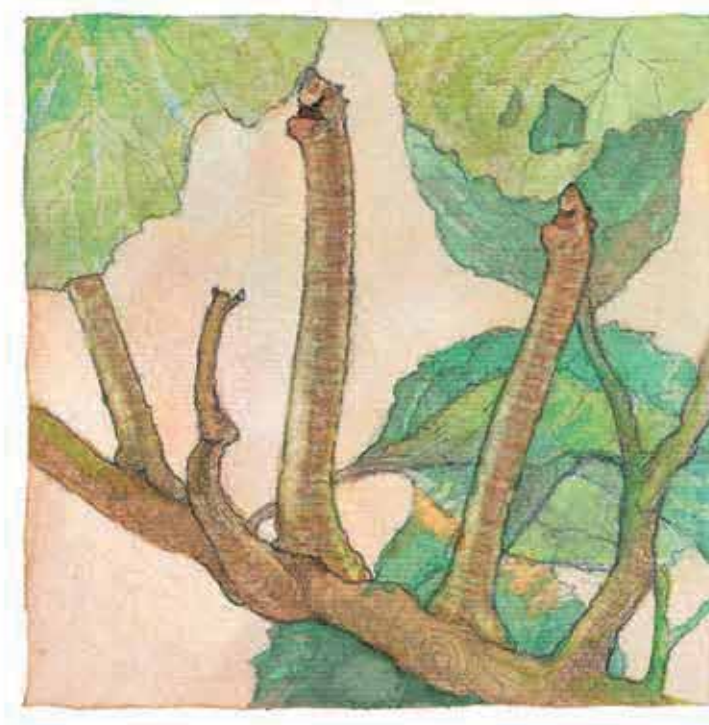
But one can gulp another down,
